## **Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Business Burglary Suspect**

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose is requesting the public's assistance in identifying the below pictured suspect in connection a business burglary.

In the early morning hours of Monday, March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019, a man broke into the Boost Mobile store, located at 30 Broadway, and stole cash and nine cell phones. Responding officers observed that an exterior metal plate cover on the 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue side of the store had been removed and is likely the way the suspect gained entry.

Detectives investigating this incident captured the below pictures of the suspect and seek the public's assistance in quickly identifying him.
