## **Newark Firefighters Extinguish Three-Alarm Fire at Vacant American History High School Today**

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose reports that some 85 members of the Newark Fire Division extinguished a three-alarm fire at the vacant American History High School at 200 Warren Street today.

Shortly before 12:30 p.m., firefighters responded to the fire. One firefighter suffered a minor injury and was transported to University Hospital for treatment. No other injuries have been reported.

The fire was considered under control at 1:59 p.m.

The cause and origin of the fire is under investigation by the Newark Fire Division's Arson Unit.
