## **Police Seek the Public's Help with Burglaries from Autos**

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose seeks the public's help with locating a white minivan that has been used in burglaries of several automobiles, including an incident that took place July 25, 2020.

The victim reported the incident to the 5<sup>th</sup> Precinct, telling officers that items were missing from her vehicle, which was parked between 2:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. on Pershing Avenue. The white Chevy minivan pictured below is believed to be involved in the theft along with other burglaries.

While detectives investigating this incident are seeking the public's help in locating the minivan, Director Ambrose urges anyone with information about the vehicle to call the Division's 24-hour Crime Stopper tip line at 1-877-NWK-TIPS (1-877-695-8477).
