Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Theft Suspects

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose requests the public's help in identifying the below pictured in an incident that occurred between September 6, 2020 and September 17, 2020.

A guest at the Best Western-Plus Hotel, 50-55 Park Place, reported that his luggage that had been left with guest services on September 6th. When he returned to pick up the bags on September 17th, the bags could not be located. Police investigating this incident obtained video surveillance footage of the below suspects removing the victim's bags. Items reported stolen include a white gold diamond engagement ring, two iPhone 11 Pro cell phones, an Apple Air Pro laptop and other personal items.
