Warrant Issued for Armed Robbery and Criminal Restraint Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose announces that a warrant has been issued for the arrest of John Mingo, 32, of the Bronx in connection with an armed robbery and criminal restraint incident that occurred on Sunday, October 11, 2020.

At approximately 12:15 a.m., police responded to the 100 block of Newton Street on a call of robbery. Two men were robbed of their cash and personal property at gunpoint before being restrained with a cord. The victims were transported to University Hospital for treatment of their injuries and released.

Detectives investigating this incident have identified John Mingo a suspect. He is wanted on charges of robbery, conspiracy to commit robbery, criminal restraint, unlawful possession of a weapon and possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose.

Director Ambrose urges anyone with information about the whereabouts of John Mingo to call the Department's 24-hour Crime Stopper tip line at 1-877-NWK-TIPS. All anonymous Crime Stopper tips are kept confidential and could result in a reward.
