Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Theft Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose requests the public's assistance in identifying the below pictured suspect in connection with the theft of a wallet on Sunday, October 11, 2020.

At approximately 7:30 p.m., a man purchased items at the mini-mart of Shell Gas Station, 972 South Orange Avenue, and dropped his wallet before leaving the store. The suspect entered the store, saw the victim's wallet and left the store with it. The victim's wallet contained cash and personal property.

Detectives investigating this incident seek the public's help in quickly identifying the suspect as part of their investigation. He was wearing a white t-shirt, blue jeans, beige and white colored sneakers and has gray hair.
