Warrant Issued for Theft Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose announces that a warrant has been issued for the arrest of Altamir Mayweathers, 18, of Newark, who is being sought for a theft that occurred on Thursday, September 24, 2020.

At approximately 6:30 p.m., police responded to Mercer and Lincoln streets on a call of a theft. A man had arrived in the area after agreeing to sell a dirt bike to a patron he met online. The suspect, Mayweathers, took the dirt bike for a test drive without returning to the area where the victim remained waiting.

Detectives investigating this incident have identified Altamir Mayweathers as a suspect in this incident. He is described as 6-ft. tall and 150 pounds. He has a medium brown complexion, black hair and brown eyes. He is known to frequent the Oscar Miles Housing Complex.

Director Ambrose urges anyone with information about the whereabouts of Altamir Mayweathers to call the Department's 24-hour Crime Stopper tip line at 1-877-NWK-TIPS. All anonymous Crime Stopper tips are kept confidential and could result in a reward.
