Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Auto Theft Suspects

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose requests the public's help in identifying the below pictured suspects in an auto theft that occurred on Friday, November 13, 2020.

A victim reported that a 2017 white BMW X6 left running in the 700 block of Springfield Avenue was stolen at approximately 4:45 p.m. The stolen vehicle was later observed at Springfield Avenue and South 20th Street. It was later seen at the Lukoil Gas Station at 335 McCarter Highway with a White or Hispanic male with long hair driving and with a second suspect who exited the rear passenger side of the vehicle.

Detectives investigating this incident identified seek the public's help in quickly identifying these suspects as part of their investigation.
