Warrant Issued for Aggravated Assault Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose reports that a warrant has been issued for the arrest of Nauhun Delgado, 34, on a charge of aggravated assault for an incident that occurred on Tuesday, November 10, 2020.

At approximately 5:50 p.m., Police responded to the area of Manor Drive near Irvington Avenue, on a call of an aggravated assault. A man was hit with bottles thrown by three males following a quarrel. The victim ran to Dunkin Donuts on Irvington Avenue, where he was then transported to University Hospital for treatment and released.

Detectives investigating this incident identified Nauhun Delgado as a suspect and obtained a warrant for his arrest. While police are actively searching for Delgado, we seek the public's help in quickly locating him as part of this investigation. He is described as 5-ft. tall and 180 to 200 pounds. He has short, dark hair and brown eyes.
