Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Theft from Auto Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose requests the public's help in identifying the below pictured suspect in connection with a theft from auto that occurred on Monday, December 21, 2020.

At approximately 1:50 a.m., a vehicle parked in the 400 block of Mulberry Street was broken into with a variety of designer clothing and accessories taken. Cash and other personal property were also removed from the vehicle.

The suspect was seen on surveillance camera exiting a gray BMW 5 series vehicle with tinted windows. The suspect is seen breaking into the victim's vehicle before re-entering the BMW and fleeing the area.

While detectives investigating this incident are actively searching for this suspect, we seek the public's help in quickly identifying this individual.
