Warrant Issued for Auto Burglary Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Anthony F. Ambrose reports that a warrant has been issued for the arrest of Alberto Cortegoso, 51, of Kearny, in connection with an auto burglary that occurred in the overnight hours of October 21, 2019.

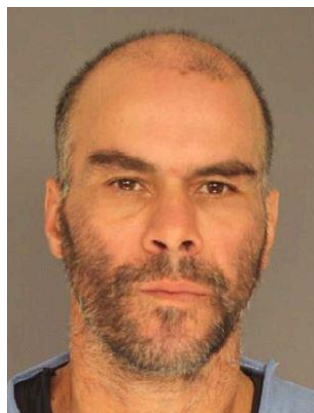
A victim reported that a vehicle parked in the 200 block of Highland Avenue was broken into and personal property and cash was stolen.

Detectives investigating this incident have identified Alberto Cortegoso as a suspect and obtained a warrant for his arrest. While police are actively searching for this suspect, we seek the public's help in quickly locating him as part of this investigation.

Cortegoso is described as 5'8" tall and 185 pounds. He has a light complexion, brown hair and brown eyes.
