Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Theft from Auto Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help in identifying the below pictured suspect in connection with a theft from auto that occurred on Monday, March 29, 2021.

At approximately 8:50 p.m., a vehicle parked at the corner of South 9th Street and 14th Avenue was broken into and the victim's personal belongings were stolen. Police investigating this incident obtained surveillance footage of an individual using the victim's credit cards at businesses in Newark. The suspect is described as female, wearing a tie-dyed sweat suit and driving a silver mini-van.

While detectives investigating this incident are actively searching for this suspect, we seek the public's help in quickly identifying this individual.
