Newark Police Vice Task Force Arrests Illegal Dumper from Kearney

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara reports that Manuel Solano, 45, of Kearny was arrested and charged with illegal dumping on April 13, 2021.

The Environmental Vice Task Force was on patrol around 9 p.m. in the area of McCarter Highway and Verona Avenue when its members observed the suspect dumping broken wood, cardboard, metal and window debris from his vehicle onto the sidewalk.

“We will not tolerate anyone illegally dumping in our city,” Director O'Hara said. “This environmental and quality of life crime is unacceptable and disrespectful to residents of the City of Newark, and we will not put up with it.”

Solano was also charged with illegal transport of solid waste.

These charges are merely an allegations. The suspect is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
