Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Armed Business Robbery Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help in identifying the below pictured male in connection with an armed business robbery that occurred on Saturday, May 29, 2021.

At approximately 8:40 p.m., police responded to a convenience store, located at 833 South 14th Street, on a call of an armed robbery. A male entered the store brandishing a gun and demanding that the employees empty the cash register. After taking approximately \$500.00, the suspect fled headed southbound on South 14th Street.

While police are actively investigating this incident, we seek the public's help in quickly identifying this suspect as part of this investigation.
