## **Police Seek Public's Help Identifying Burglary Suspect**

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help with identifying the below-pictured suspects about a burglary that occurred May 25, 2021.

Police responded to a call about a burglary in progress around 2 a.m. at a deli in the 100 block of Halsey Street. Upon arrival, officers saw that the glass to the front door of the business had been shattered and that items inside were missing. The suspects, captured on surveillance video, broke into the business and took money from the register. One of the suspects was wearing blue jeans and a yellow shirt and the other suspect wore burgundy shorts and a grey shirt.

While detectives investigate this incident and seeks the public's help with identifying this suspect, Director O'Hara urges anyone with information about the individual to call the Division's 24-hour Crime Stopper tip line at 1-877-NWK-TIPS (1-877-695-8477).
