Police Seek Public's Help Identifying Theft Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara request's the public's help with identifying the below-pictures suspect in connection with a theft that occurred at a supermarket on September 19, 2021.

The victim told police that he left his cellphone around 5 p.m. at the City Supermarket, located in the 500 block of Irvington Avenue. When he returned, the phone was gone. The suspect in the picture below was captured on surveillance camera removing the victim's cell phone after the victim walked away. He was wearing black jeans, a grey cap and a grey T-shirt with "South Orange New Jersey" written on the front.
