## **Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Business Burglary Suspect**

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help in identifying the below-pictured suspect in connection with a business burglary that occurred on Sunday, September 26, 2021.

Just before 2 a.m., a man entered a door on the main level of Pillar College, located at 60 Park Place, and removed a Dell laptop. The suspect then fled, heading eastbound on East Park Place.

While detectives investigating this incident are actively searching for this suspect, we request the public's help in quickly identifying him as part of their investigation. He is described as having a thin build with a goatee and slight mustache, and wearing jeans, a bubble coat and a baseball cap turned backwards.
