Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Carjacking Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help in identifying the below-pictured suspect in connection with a carjacking that occurred on Sunday, September 12, 2021.

At approximately 5:45 p.m., police responded to Martin Luther King Boulevard and West Kinney Street on a call of a carjacking. A male suspect pulled the victim out of his vehicle, a 2016 Honda Accord, just after parking. The suspect entered the vehicle and fled. The victim was treated by EMS at the scene for minor cuts due to falling after being pulled. Police later recovered the vehicle, running and unoccupied, in the 100 block of Barclay Street.

Detectives investigating this incident obtained the below photos of the suspect and request the public's help in quickly identifying this suspect as part of their investigation.
