## **Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Suspect for Discharging Firearm**

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help in identifying the below pictured male in connection with discharging a firearm within the city on Wednesday, September 22, 2021.

Just after 4:30 p.m., police responded to the area of Chadwick Avenue, near Clinton Avenue, on a call of shots fired. Responding officers observed evidence of gunfire, but no victims have been located.

Detectives investigating this incident obtained photos of the below suspect and seek the public's help in quickly identifying him as part of their investigation.
