UPDATE: Police Seek Public's Help Identifying Burglary Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Brian A. O'Hara requests the public's help with identifying the below-pictured suspect, who was captured on surveillance video breaking the front glass of a business and taking money from the cash register on April 10, 2022.

Police responded to a call about a burglary that occurred around 3:08 a.m. at a store that sells religious goods on Prospect Street. When the officers arrived, they saw the glass to the front door shattered and there was rock on the floor.

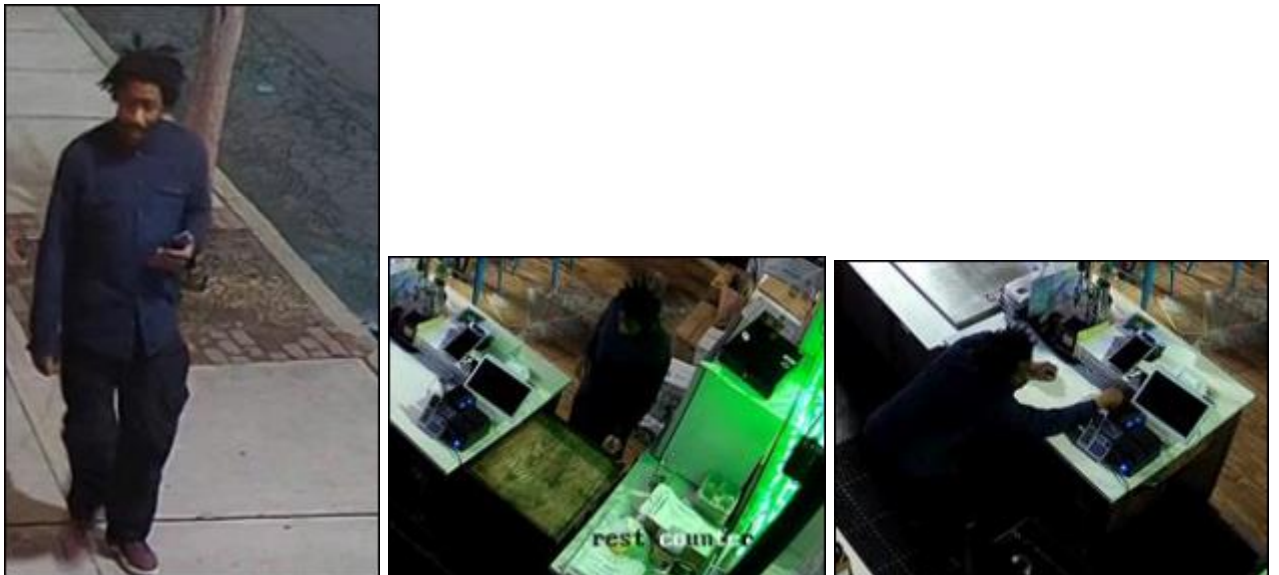
A week later, on April 17, 2022, the same suspect broke into another business around 2:38 a.m. in the 1200 block of Raymond Boulevard. He was captured on surveillance taking money from the cash register and leaving, heading eastbound on Raymond Boulevard toward Broad Street. During this incident, the suspect was wearing a blue button down shirt, burgundy sneakers and black pants. He's described as a Black male between 5'8" to 6'0" with a close cut beard, medium brown complexion and a dreadlock hairstyle.

Director O'Hara urges anyone with information about the suspect to call the Police Division's 24-hour Crime Stopper tip line at 1-877-NWK-TIPS (1-877-695-8477). All anonymous Crime Stopper tips are kept confidential and could result in a reward.
