Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Burglary Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Fritz G. Fragé requests the public's help in identifying the below-pictured male suspect in connection with a burglary that occurred on Monday, August 29, 2022.

At approximately 1:30 a.m., Police responded to a call of a burglary at Smitty's Mobile Exxon, 101 13th Avenue. The suspect entered the business by shattering a garage window. He then removed a cash box containing \$300.00 and two vehicles, a black 2003 Mercedes Benz, which has been recovered by Police, and a silver 2009 Honda Accord LX, which has not yet been recovered.
