Police Seek the Public's Help in Identifying Theft Suspects

Newark Public Safety Fritz G. Fragé requests the public's help in identifying the below-pictured suspects in connection with a theft that occurred on Monday, September 5, 2022.

At approximately 8:15 p.m., Police responded to a call of a theft in the 200 block of Ferry Street. A female victim's black and gold Kate Spade purse was stolen while she was dining. Two males, who were seated behind the victim, left the establishment with one suspect appearing to be hiding something under his clothing.

Detectives investigating this incident seek the public's help in identifying the two suspects. Suspect 1 is described as 5'1" tall and wearing black clothing. Suspect 2 is also described as 5'1" tall wearing black clothing.
