### **Water Main Break at Route 21 Causing Traffic Delays**

Newark Public Safety Director Fritz G. Fragé announces that a 6-inch water main break at Route 21, between Clay Street and the Rt. 280 ramp exit, is causing traffic delays in the area.

Residential water is not affected.
