Police Seek Public's Help Identifying Shooting Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Fritz G. Fragé requests the public's help with identifying the below-pictured suspect, who fired several shots at an unidentified vehicle on September 2, 2022.

Police officers responded to a ShotSpotter Detection, which picked up shots fired at approximately 10:33 p.m. in the 100 block of 19th Avenue. When officers arrived, they canvassed the area and recovered seven, 9mm casings from that location to the intersection of 19th Avenue and South 20th Street. A vehicle traveling on South 20th Street was struck by the gunfire.

The suspect is described as a 5'8" inch tall Black male with a medium build. He has a dreadlock hairstyle and was wearing a black sweatshirt with a hood, a dark-colored ski mask, grey pants and a fanny pack. The suspect, who was last seen running northbound on South 20th Street toward Irvington, is known to be around the 700 block of South 20th Street.

Director Fragé urges anyone with information about the suspect to call the Police Division's 24-hour Crime Stopper tip line at 1-877-NWK-TIPS (1-877-695-8477). All anonymous Crime Stopper tips are kept confidential and could result in a reward.
