Police Seek Help Identifying Theft Suspect

Newark Public Safety Director Fritz G. Fragé requests the public's help identifying the below-pictured male suspect in connection with a theft that occurred on Thursday, January 5, 2023.

A victim reported that his package, delivered just before 10:15 a.m., was stolen from his porch in the 200 block of Fairmount Avenue. The package contained an 18K agate necklace valued at over \$620.00.

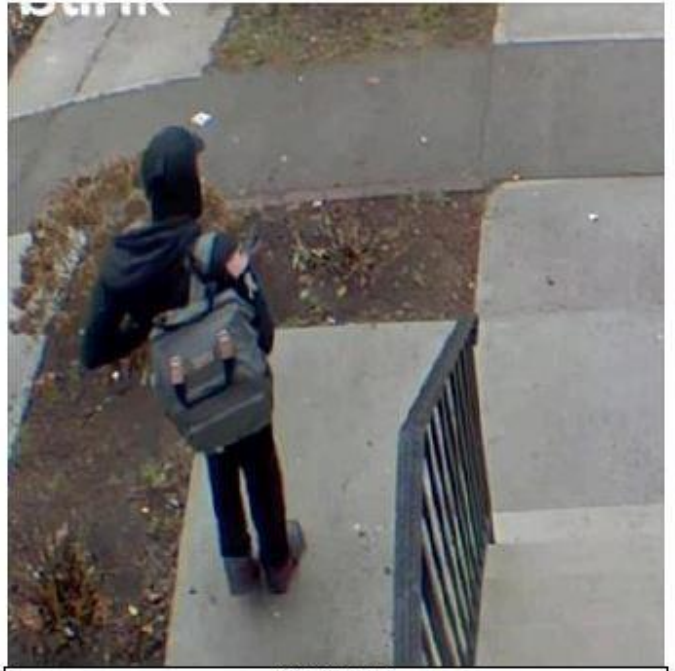
Detectives investigating this incident obtained surveillance footage of the suspect approaching the victim's porch at approximately 10:22 a.m. and placing the delivered package into a gray backpack before fleeing, heading southbound on Fairmount Avenue towards South Orange Avenue. He is described as Black, 5'10" tall, with a thin build. He was wearing a navy-blue baseball cap with a gold symbol, a navy-blue hooded sweatshirt with gold lettering on the chest area, black pants, gray sneakers, and carrying a gray backpack.
