Street Closures Announced for Annual Newark St. Patrick's Day Parade Friday, March 10, 2023

Newark Public Safety Director Fritz G. Fragé announces that due to the Newark Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade, scheduled to begin at 1 p.m. to 3 p.m., on Friday, March 10, 2023, the following streets will be closed during designated hours:

***6 a.m.**

- Halsey Street between Bleeker Street and Central Avenue (south side at Central Avenue, across from Kilkenny Alehouse)

***10 a.m.**

- Mulberry Street between Market Street and Raymond Boulevard
- Raymond Boulevard (south side – eastbound) between Broad Street and McCarter Highway
- Clinton Street between Broad Street and Mulberry Street
- Commerce Street between McCarter Highway and Broad Street
- Beaver Street between Market Street and Clinton Street

***11:30 a.m.**

- Center Street between McCarter Highway and Broad Street

***12:30 p.m.**

- Mulberry Street: Between Raymond Blvd. and Center Street
- Center Street: Between McCarter Highway and Broad Street (11:30 a.m.)
- Central Avenue: Between Broad Street and University Avenue
- Clinton Street: Between Broad and Mulberry Streets
- Beaver Street: Between Market and Clinton Streets
- Commerce Street: Between McCarter Highway and Broad Street
- E. Park Street: Between Park Place and Mulberry Street
- Park Place: Between Raymond Boulevard and Center Street
- Rector Street: Between McCarter Highway and Broad Street

- Halsey Street: Between Washington Place and Central Avenue (7 a.m.)
- Washington Street: Between Raymond Boulevard and Washington Place
- Washington Place: Between Washington and Broad Streets
